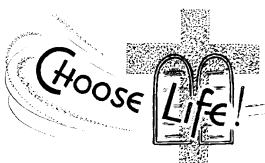

## ASH WEDNESDAY

**This coming Wednesday, 18<sup>th</sup> February, is Ash Wednesday** and marks the beginning of Lent. As per the ancient practice of the Church, abstinence from meat, and fasting, are to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. (All who have completed their eighteenth year and have not begun their sixtieth year are bound to fast. All who have completed their fourteenth year are bound to abstain from meat). On all other Fridays, the common practice of penance is fulfilled by any one of the following:

- Prayer – e.g. Mass attendance; family prayer; a visit to a church or chapel; reading the Bible; making the Stations of the Cross; praying the Rosary.
- Fasting or Self-denial – e.g. not eating meat; not eating sweets or dessert; giving up entertainment to spend time with the family; limiting food and drink so as to give the money to the poor.
- Almsgiving or Helping others – e.g. special attention to someone who is poor, sick, elderly, lonely or overburdened or some other act of charity, like donating to the Project Compassion Appeal.

### PASCHAL PRECEPT

Each of the faithful is obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. This is to be done between Ash Wednesday and Trinity Sunday unless for a good reason it is done at another time during the year. All the faithful are obliged to confess their grave sins at least once a year.

### STATIONS OF THE CROSS DURING LENT

**Commencing from this Friday, 20<sup>th</sup> February**, the Stations of the Cross will be held on each Friday's during Lent. Please come along at 6.00pm in St Francis Xavier's Church. St Joseph's will have the Stations of the Cross at 6.30pm followed by Mass at 7.00pm.

### FIRST RECONCILIATION PROGRAM 2026

**All Catholic baptised children currently in Year 4 at school or over** who attend St Gabriel's, St Francis Xavier's, St Joseph's or any of the public schools within our parish are scheduled to make their First Reconciliation in Term 1 and their First Holy Communion in Term 2. Accordingly, there will be a Parent Information Evening on **Thursday, 26<sup>th</sup> February**, in St Joseph's Hall at 7.00pm **for the parents of the children.**

At least one parent or guardian of a child is expected to attend this meeting as the Registration Form for the programme will be handed out on the night. There will also be some general information about the First Holy Communion program on the night.

**You are asked to bring a copy (not the original) of your child's Catholic Baptism Certificate to the meeting.**

There is ample parking in the school grounds off Parker St, Rockdale.
