
Response to the Prayer for Catechists

HOW TO RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION

Catholics who have made the proper spiritual and sacramental preparation may come forward in the procession to receive Holy Communion. To receive the sacred host, please hold your hands open flat and then consume the host in the presence of the priest or communion minister before moving back to your seat.



If you are not Catholic or have not yet received your First Communion, you may receive a blessing **from the priest.**

An Acolyte or Minister of Holy Communion cannot give you a blessing. To receive a blessing approach the priest in the Communion procession with your arms crossed over your chest.

Accordingly, there will be a Parent Information Evening on **Thursday, 26th February**, in St Joseph's Hall at 7.00pm **for the parents of the children.**

At least one parent or guardian of a child is expected to attend this meeting as the Registration Form for the programme will be handed out on the night. There will also be some general information about the First Holy Communion program on the night.

You are asked to bring a copy (not the original) of your child's Catholic Baptism Certificate to the meeting.
