

# THREE COMMUNITIES, ONE PARISH MERGER OF ST GABRIEL'S PARISH, BEXLEY & ST MARY MACKILLOP'S PARISH, ROCKDALE CITY

As you know a survey was held across both parishes throughout December 2024 to canvas current opinion on the formal merger of the two parishes. The result was that 89% supported the merger, and 86% were in favour of retaining the name of St Mary MacKillop's Parish, Rockdale City. Written support was given to the merge by both St Gabriel's Parish Finance Committee and St Mary MacKillop's Parish Finance Committee.

Subsequently I wrote to the Archbishop, The Most Reverend Anthony Fisher OP, in April formally asking on behalf of St Gabriel's and St Mary MacKillop's parishioners that the canonical merge of the two parishes be considered. The matter was put before the Council of Priests on 29<sup>th</sup> April 2025. I was subsequently advised on 30<sup>th</sup> April that the Council had endorsed the merge, and that the Archbishop had given his approval.

The Archdiocese is currently finalising the Decrees for signature by the Archbishop. Once the Decrees have been received, they will be put on display in each church for a period of ten days. After that time, and following final acceptance by both Parishes, St Gabriel's Parish Bexley will be incorporated into St Mary MacKillop's Parish Rockdale City. Naturally the names of the individual churches and schools will not change.

To keep you up to date, you will receive further information via the Bulletin and from the pulpit in the coming weeks.
