

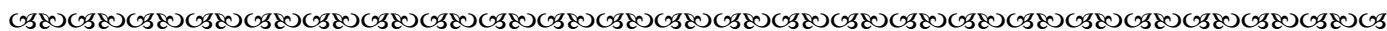

Applications are to be one A4 page, or less, and outline why you are interested in joining the Committee and what strengths and experience you would bring to PFC deliberations.

While the Committee aims for an even balance of Arncliffe and Rockdale representatives; of women and men; and a range of ages, PFC members will primarily be selected on the basis of ability, experience and commitment.

The PFC meets of an evening at the Parish Office. Meetings last between two and three hours. There are usually four to six meetings each year.

Applications must be received at the Parish Office by **9am, Monday 19th February**. Applications can be emailed to admin@mmrc.org.au or placed in the Office letterbox at 13 Parker Street, Rockdale. Late applications will not be considered. Applicants will be advised, in writing, of the outcome of the selection process. The decision of the Parish Priest will be final.

CHURCH SERVICE DRESS CODE REMINDER

As we enter the summer season, we kindly remind you to dress modestly when attending Church. While our dress code is not as strict as the Vatican’s, your cooperation in maintaining a respectful atmosphere during worship is highly appreciated.

Please kindly refrain from wearing attire that is more suitable for the gym or the beach. We kindly ask that you avoid low-cut clothing and belly crop tops. When it comes to pants or skirts, low-cut short pants or skirts are not encouraged. However, slightly above the knee length is acceptable, provided they are decent and uphold a sense of reverence. This is particularly important if you are an Acolyte or Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist.

Men and boys are also asked to remove caps and beanies before entering the church in a sign of respect to the Blessed Sacrament.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation in upholding a respectful environment during the church services.
