SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

This is an advance notice for families who live in the Parish and who wish their child to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation this year. The <u>parent</u> Information Evening will be held this coming Thursday, 31st July at 7.00pm in St Joseph's Hall. A parent is expected to attend the meeting. The actual Sacrament will be conferred in September. Children who are currently in Years 5 and 6 at school or above are eligible to be Confirmed. However, they must be Baptised Catholics and have received the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist. Proof of reception of these Sacraments is a requirement.

If your child is not currently attending St Joseph's Primary, St Francis Xavier's Primary or St Gabriel's Primary, we ask that you email the parish office (admin@mmrc.org.au) to get an information letter about the Confirmation Program for 2025. The children must attend four instruction lessons during the weekends in August.
